

STORM & FLOODING PROCEDURES

Winter rains can cause high winds, flooding and uprooted trees on campus.

During the Storm:

- If water has entered a building or walkway, do not walk through it, it may contain hazardous materials.
- Do not try to drive over a flooded road. If your car stalls, abandon it immediately. Attempting to move a stalled vehicle in flood conditions can be fatal.
- Tune a radio or TV to local channels for emergency advisories and instructions.
- Look for e-mails from Campus Public Safety or Facility Services warning of unsafe events of campus.
- Report all flooding inside of a building to Facility Services.
